### **Three Van Buren Justices of the Peace Endorse Rose for State Representative**

**VAN BUREN, Ark.** (Jan. 18, 2022) – Justices of the Peace Daniel Perry, Mark Shaffer and Michael Morrison have endorsed River Valley pastor and small business owner Ryan Rose in his campaign for District 48 State Representative.
